Information for interns and RMOs

- The Australasian Faculty of Public Health Medicine is responsible for Public Health Physician (FAFPHM) training
- Training may be completed in 3 years (full-time) or up to 7 years (part-time)

Pre-requisites for FAFPHM training

For entry into the FAFPHM training program, applicants must have:

- medical registration in Australia.
- completed basic training requirements
- at least 3 years of medical experience since graduating (including at least 2 years of clinical experience, one of which being the intern year); and
- completed, or are enrolled in, a Master of Public Health (or comparable Masters Degree)*
- obtained an accredited Public Health training position in Australia- please note it is up to the applicant to secure this position.

**The degree program must be completed before you can progress to the second year of Advanced Training*
